- ___ Challenge Items > Any size - Includes items made for the 2016 Challenge
- Miniature Quilt > Quilt must be miniature in scale and 100" total perimeter or smaller.
- Small Quilt Pieced > Includes quilts between 100" and up to 216" total perimeter that are predominately (more that 50%) hand or machine pieced
- Small Quilt Appliquéd > Includes quilts between 100" and up to 216" total perimeter that are predominately (more than 50%) hand or machine *appliquéd*.
- Medium Quilt Pieced > Includes quilts between 216" and up to 300" total perimeter that are predominately (more that 50%) hand or machine pieced.
- Medium Quilt Appliquéd > Includes quilts between 216" and up to 300" total perimeter that are predominately (more than 50%) hand or machine *appliquéd*.
- Large Quilt Pieced > Includes quilts 300" and larger total perimeter that are predominately (more that 50%) hand or machine pieced.
- Large Quilt Appliquéd > Includes quilts 300" and larger total perimeter that are predominately (more than 50%) hand or machine *appliquéd*.

Specialty Quilt > Any size – Includes quilts with construction that does not fit into the above categories.

Examples: T-Shirt, Photo Memory, Cathedral Window, Whole Cloth, Yo-Yo, Crazy Quilt, woven, and Hand pieced & Hand quilted.

Mixed Techniques > Any size – Includes quilts using mixed techniques.

Examples: Embroidery and piecing, pieced background with appliqué on top, mixed pieced and appliquéd blocks and Art Quilts using non-traditional techniques; such as method, fabric embellishment, or surface design.– to be used as a piece of art.

Other Items > Includes wearable art, purses, bags, table runners, pillows, textile dyeing, textile painting, fabric constructed artifacts, quilted or other fiber techniques.

Junior Quilt > All sizes: Exhibitor 16 or younger

Sleeve: All quilts larger than Miniature category must have a 4" sleeve for hanging. Straight pins and Safety pins will not be permitted. You will be asked to make an appropriate adjustment if this requirement is not met upon registration.

Photo: A color photo or photocopy must be provided by member and submitted with Entry Form. Write on the back of the photo your name and the title of the quilt/item. The photo will assist us in coordinating the display. The photo or photocopy will not be returned.

Description: Write a brief story about your quilt or other item. This will appear on the quilt show display label. Information you could include: Design inspiration, pattern source, instructor or workshop, and other insight to quilt making process. Please limit your narrative to 50 or less words. It may be edited due to space.
