CANCELLATION POLICY

If you must cancel your registration more than one week before the start of camp, you will receive a full refund of your registration. There will be a cancellation fee of \$20 if you need to cancel less than one week before the start of camp.

IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT CAMP

Arrival and Departure: Camp begins at 1pm on Tuesday, September 12 and ends at 12noon on Sunday, September 18.

Prescription Medications: In the case of an emergency, please have a list of your prescription medications with you.

Telephone & Wi-Fi Access: Mt Hope has Wi-Fi, but no cell phone access. Their landline is available for calls out with a phone card.

Smoking & Alcohol: Mt Hope's policies do not allow smoking or alcohol on their grounds or in their buildings.

Dorms: There are 4 dorms available. The 3 largest dorms (Faith, Charity & Hope) each have 8 rooms. A sink, 2 twin bunks and a trundle are in each room (sleeps 2 -3 comfortably). Each dorm has two large, shared bathrooms with private showers and toilet areas. Victory Cabin can sleep up to 5, has 2 toilets and showers, and a small sitting area.
